	Buy a City Pass Small 72 hours for DKK 200. It covers buses, metro and trains from the airport and includes the Central Copenhagen.
How to buy a City Pass Small	lt's easy:
	<ol> <li>Follow the link to buy a City Pass.</li> <li>Complete the order form.</li> <li>Instantly receive your City Pass and a receipt via SMS and e-mail.</li> <li>City Pass English - DOT (dinoffentligetransport.dk)</li> </ol>
	(The ticket module opens in a new window)
	NB. Use the drop down menu 'Type Country' to select country. This will automatically add the country code to your phone number, i.e. there is no need to enter the country code yourself. Or:
	You can buy your City Pass with the "DOT Tickets" app.
	App Store Google Play
	You can also buy City Pass at the ticket vending machine at all stations and at the airport.
	Or you can buy your City Pass online at <a href="https://www.city-pass.dk">www.city-pass.dk</a> and receive it as an SMS.
At arrival in Copenhagen Airport:	Take the metro, line M2 direction Vanløse st. Change at Kongens Nytorv to M4 direction Orientkaj and get off at "Orientkaj". From here you have 123 steps (according to the hotel) to Comwell Copenhagen Portside
